SUBJECT: Erosion & Sediment Control Training for Contractors that have a Sewer Tappers License through the Metropolitan Sewer District of Cincinnati

Dear MSD Sewer Tapper License Holder,

Enclosed you will find the Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Field Handbook for small utility construction projects. This Handbook was developed through a cooperative agreement between the Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District and the Metropolitan Sewer District of Cincinnati. The Handbook was created to educate MSD Sewer Tappers on the Best Management Practices used in erosion prevention and sediment control for small scale utility projects.

As part of this working agreement, contractors who hold a Sewer Tappers License are required to read the Manual and take the attached test. The test shall be taken by project superintendents or anyone who will be responsible for installing, inspecting, and maintaining erosion prevention and sediment control practices. After completing the test mail it back to: Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District, 29 Triangle Park Drive, Suite 2901, Cincinnati, Ohio 45246-341, Attention: Chey Alberto or Fax the test to (513) 772 – 7656. Before mailing or faxing your test back to the District check to be sure that you provide all of the contact information for your company on the cover page of the test.

The District and MSD expect all contractors to install, inspect, and maintain erosion prevention and sediment control practices throughout the construction process. The District will mail each contractor a certification after successfully completing this course.
