

## **MSD Executive Director Named Public Administrator of the Year**

Tony Parrott, Executive Director of the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati, received the 2013 Public Administrator of the Year Award, Innovation Category, during an awards ceremony on April 19, 2013 at The Phoenix in downtown Cincinnati.

Parrott was honored for his leadership in developing an innovative approach to reduce combined sewer overflows (CSOs). The wet weather strategy that MSD is implementing in the City of Cincinnati is viewed as a model for other urban communities across the U.S. that are under federal mandates to reduce CSOs. In addition, he was recognized for his vision to implement a shared services initiative between Greater Cincinnati Water Works and the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati, which is expected to save between \$68 and \$105 million over the next 10 years.
