TRAFFIC ALERT

Lane Restrictions and Road Closure for Queen City Avenue at White Street in South Fairmount

CINCINNATI – Beginning Friday, September 23, 2016, Queen City Avenue will be restricted to one lane in the vicinity of White Street <u>for one week</u> as part of ongoing construction. Note: Queen City Avenue is a one-way westbound street.

Additionally, Queen City Avenue at White Street will be closed to traffic for one weekend from 6:30 p.m. Friday, September 30 through 5 a.m. Monday, October 3.

Access to White Street from Queen City Avenue will not be available. Local traffic will need to access White Street via Fairmount Avenue/Harrison Avenue.

Traffic on Queen City Avenue will be detoured via Quebec Road to Glenway Avenue to Rapid Run Pike/Sunset Avenue to Queen City Avenue.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is installing storm sewers along White Street and adjacent areas through spring 2017 as part of the Lick Run Project.
