MSD Notice of Construction

Sanitary Sewer Overflow 700 (SSO 700) Operational Improvements

CINCINNATI – The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) will be implementing operational improvements at the SSO 700 storage and treatment facility located in the City of Reading. Work is anticipated to begin the week of March 14, 2016 with completion in the fall of 2016.

The SSO 700 Operational Improvements project consists of enhancements to the electrical and instrumentation and control systems at the storage and treatment facility. It will improve operational reliability, mitigate safety problems, and will enable the facility to perform with less maintenance.

Construction will occur primarily Monday through Friday during daylight hours, depending on the contractor's schedule. Some weekend work may be necessary at times. MSD's construction contractor is Lake Erie Electric.

This project is part of Project Groundwork, MSD's multi-year plan to reduce sewer overflows into streams and rivers in Hamilton County. Project Groundwork will improve the quality of our lives through cleaner streams, improved protection of public health, and enhancement of the communities where we live, work, and play.
