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MSD Lick Run Project Update and Traffic Alert

Weekend Work on Queen City Avenue near Lafeuille in Westwood

CINCINNATI – Construction work will occur along Queen City Avenue near Lafeuille Avenue in Westwood over the weekends of August 10 and August 17, pending weather and site conditions.

Traffic on Queen City Avenue will be reduced to one lane in both directions through the intersection with Lafeuille. Traffic can turn onto Lafeuille, but there will be no dedicated turn lanes.

The work will occur from about 7 p.m. Friday, Aug. 10 to 5 a.m. Monday, Aug. 13 and again from about 7 p.m. Friday, Aug. 17 to 5 a.m. Monday, Aug. 20.

This project is part of an ongoing effort by the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) to install new storm sewers along Queen City Avenue between Sunset Avenue and the Vantage Pointe West apartment complex.

Part of the Lick Run Project (www.projectgroundwork.org/lickrun), this initiative will keep rainwater out of MSD's sewer system and help reduce sewer overflows into the Mill Creek. The new storm sewers will collect rainwater and convey it to the Lick Run Greenway in South Fairmount.

Work began in early January and should be completed by the end of the year, with final restoration in spring 2019.
