## **TRAFFIC ALERT**

### **Lane Restrictions in Spring Grove Village Early April through Spring 2019**

CINCINNATI – Temporary lane restrictions will occur along Kings Run Drive and Winton Ridge Lane in Spring Grove Village beginning in early April through spring 2019, weather permitting.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is installing new storm sewers and other sewer infrastructure as part of a multi-year, multi-phased construction project. This federally mandated project is part of MSD's solution in the Kings Run watershed to reduce combined sewer overflows (CSOs) into the Mill Creek.

About 900 feet of new storm sewer, 700 feet of sanitary sewer, and about 4,000 feet of relocated combined sewer will be constructed in the area via open-cut construction.

Traffic will be down to one lane in each direction in the vicinity of the construction work. As the construction moves, the traffic pattern change will move with it. There may be a few times over the course of the construction when traffic will be down to one lane, with a flagger used to move traffic in each direction.

Work is expected to start along Kings Run Drive near Este Avenue.

MSD's construction contractor is Ford Development Company. Construction activity is anticipated between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Work on Fridays or weekends may be needed due to weather or schedule changes.

In addition to traffic inconveniences, typical construction-related disturbances such as noise, dirt and vibrations should be expected throughout the construction period.

This project is part of Project Groundwork, MSD's multi-year plan to reduce sewer overflows into streams and rivers in Hamilton County. Project Groundwork will protect public health, improve our local streams and rivers and enhance our communities.
