Traffic Alert Update – Columbia Tusculum/East End

Traffic on Delta Avenue to be Detoured at Columbia Parkway Beginning March 4

CINCINNATI – Traffic on Delta Avenue in the vicinity of Columbia Parkway will be detoured starting Monday, March 4 for about two weeks for sewer-related work, pending weather and field conditions.

The detour will affect all traffic on Delta, with the exception of southbound traffic going west on Columbia Parkway and northbound traffic going east on Columbia Parkway. *Please see the attached project map.*

Access to local traffic and emergency vehicles will be maintained. This work is part of an ongoing MSD sewer project along Columbia Parkway near Delta that began in early January.

In addition to traffic inconveniences, typical construction-related disturbances such as noise, dirt and vibrations should be expected throughout the construction period. Project updates will be shared via press releases and Twitter @CincinnatiMSD.

This project is part of Project Groundwork, MSD's multi-year plan to reduce sewer overflows into streams and rivers in Hamilton County. Project Groundwork will improve the quality of our lives through cleaner streams, improved protection of public health, and enhancement of the communities where we live, work, and play.

Immediately following the conclusion of MSD's sewer project, the Cincinnati Department of Transportation and Engineering (DOTe) will begin a street rehabilitation project along Columbia Parkway from Delta to Beechmont avenues. DOTe will issue a separate update for their project.
