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TRAFFIC ALERT UPDATE

White Street in South Fairmount to Close for 8-10 Weeks

CINCINNATI – White Street in South Fairmount between Queen City and Fairmount avenues will be closed to through traffic starting the week of Nov. 21 and continuing for 8-10 weeks.

It was previously reported on November 18 that White Street would close for 4-6 weeks.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is installing storm sewers along White Street and adjacent areas through spring 2017 as part of the Lick Run Project.

The work will progress north on White Street one block at a time, starting between Queen City Avenue and Horton Street.

Local and emergency traffic will be maintained, but delays are possible. Traffic can detour via Fairmount Avenue/Harrison Avenue/Queen City Avenue. *Please see attached map for location of the road closure.*

The Lick Run Project is part of Project Groundwork, MSD's multi-year plan to reduce sewer overflows into streams and rivers in Hamilton County. Project Groundwork will protect public health, improve our local streams and rivers, and enhance our communities.
