Shields Street Sinkhole Sewer Repairs Complete

UPDATE:

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) has completed the repair of a nearly 100-year-old sewer line under Shields Street, which collapsed in June and caused a sinkhole that closed the street for more than a month.

The collapsed section of pipe was replaced, and the entire sewer segment was rehabilitated with cured-in-place lining. The by-pass pumps have been removed, the shafts have been dismantled and backfilled. The pavement has been restored on Shields Street and E. Shields Street (east of Vine Street), and all lanes are back in service.
