**Subject: Waste Haulers License Permit Renewal (2009) for the
Metropolitan Sewer District of Hamilton County, Ohio**

This is a reminder regarding the renewal of your Waste Haulers holding tank discharge permit for 2009. The annual license fee is **\$140.00** for each truck and shall cover one year beginning January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 in accordance with the Metropolitan Sewer District Rules and Regulations, effective March 1, 2001.

Enclosed is a copy of the following for processing:

- Revised application form for the permit to discharge.
- Waste haulers bond form. Also note that the bond is on the MSD WEB Site at www.msdbg.org and it is interactive for your convenience.
- A copy of the MSD Rules and Regulations, Article XIV, regarding the disposal of the holding tank waste.

Please remit directly to MSD, 1600 Gest Street, Room 100, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, attention: Mr. Pat Sheehan, the following:

1. A check, payable to the Treasurer, City of Cincinnati, for **\$140.00** for each truck.
2. Executed, original bond form with a current power of attorney.

Please remit directly to MSD, 1600 Gest Street, Division of Industrial Waste, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, attention: Mr. Chris Hall, P.E. the following:

1. The enclosed permit to discharge.

Please note that the Metropolitan Sewer District has made the decision to stop receiving industrial waste at the Mill Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant septage receiving station in 2009. The Division of Industrial Waste is developing policies and procedures to effect this change. The division will send permitted companies a detailed notification in the near future. If you have any questions or concerns about this matter please contact Mr. Christopher Hall, P.E., at 513-557-7011.

It should be noted that the name of the business listed on the discharge permit and the bond for each truck should be the same as the name of the business that is listed with the Ohio Secretary of State. Any discrepancy in information will cause a delay in processing your discharge permit and bond. Once your discharge permit is approved MSD will then process you hauler's bond.

The permit will be issued for sanitary sewage originating in the District Service Area only. Please note that permits to haul sewage to MSD originating outside the service area of Industrial Waste (including grease traps, car wash pits, utility chambers, etc.) will be issued separately. Please contact Chris Hall, P.E., of the Division of Industrial Waste at (513) 557-7011 for additional information regarding these permits.

Permits and discharge tickets are issued, either by mail or in person at the Metropolitan Sewer District, 1600 Gest Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, at the Tap Records Customer Service Counter between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on Holidays. **The fee for the year 2009 is \$50.00 per 1,000 gallons for both the sanitary and commercial dumping tickets.** The method of payment is check or currency (for in person service) only.

NO discharging of any substance directly into a manhole or other opening in the wastewater treatment system is permitted as per MSD Rules & Regulations Article XV Section 1516.
