

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby adopts and approves the 2018-2022 Capital Improvement Program for the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati in the amount of \$129,118,155; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby adopts and approves the 2018 MSD Operating Budget in the amount of \$211,217,612; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby adopts legislation approving Project ID 10280717 authorizing Critical Asset Management Projects for 2017 in the amount of \$8,951,990 subject to additional terms in this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the BOCC ratifies and affirms that MSDGC shall comply with all MSD Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to those related to reporting and financial practices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that MSD and the County shall meet during Quarter 1 of 2018 to resolve policy questions around the use of District funds for the repair, maintenance and renovation of building sewers including the use of allowance spending theron; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pending future discussions with Consent Decree Regulators and the US District Court, future project spending associated with this 5-year CIP, relating to asset management and WWIP shall be amended, as needed and directed, to reflect the policy position of the Board of County Commissioners; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate capitalization of costs for 10130740 Werk & Westbourne EHRT, 10140417 LMCPR Monitoring and Modeling, and 10199018 Program Management and Support Services will be discussed in early 2018 and adjusted as needed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Project Number 10199118 "Hamilton County Utility Oversight and Coordination 2018" reflects a total of \$1,000,000 for 2018 an amount which is reduced from the 2017 CIP and which shall be tracked and amended on a quarterly basis, if needed and as directed by the Board of County Commissioners, in conjunction with the oversight needs of the County including but not limited to WWIP and Consent Decree negotiations with Federal Regulators; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that references in the attached legislation to Project 10280518 WWC
High Risk Asset Renewal 2018 shall reference that "The scope of work does not include addressing building sewers as those are the legal responsibility of the building owner/operator and not MSDGC."; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding allocated within the 2018 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Program is consistent with advancing the recommendations of the Hamilton County/MSD Rate Affordability Task Force and that the County and MSD will continue to jointly advance those recommendations as expeditiously as possible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that individual projects associated with the Critical Asset Management work of the Metropolitan Sewer District shall not commence until project description and cost detail is received, reviewed and approved by the County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board certify copies of this resolution to Jeff Aluotto, County Administrator; and Dusty Rhodes, County Auditor.



The submitted 2017 operating budget reflects that:

- MSD continues to demonstrate fiscal responsibility and provides for operational needs;
- This budget request is 8.3% less than the approved 2017 budget;
- This budget request does not include any additional costs that may occur as a result of the anticipated transition from City to County management;
- The personnel budget request maintains the 2017 staffing plan level;
- About 44% of the operating budget (\$93M) is allocated to pay debt service related to consent decree driven and other capital improvements;
- About 21% of the requested budget (\$43.9M) is allocated to MSD's wastewater treatment operation ("WWT");
- About 10% of the requested budget (\$20.3M) is allocated to MSD's wastewater collection operation ("WWC")

The proposed operating budget without debt service is \$118,255,000.

The Board held public hearings on the MSD 2018 Operating Budget on November 8 and 15, 2017, thereby affording all interested parties the opportunity to comment. The hearings were advertised in the Cincinnati Enquirer on October 28, 2017, November 4 and 11, 2017.
