Notice of Construction and Traffic Alert for Norwood

Minor Traffic Impacts and Non-Toxic Odors in 2000-2100 block of Williams Avenue on October 6-7

CINCINNATI – Minor traffic impacts and non-toxic odors will occur in the 2000-2100 block of Williams Avenue in the vicinity of Williams Avenue Elementary School in Norwood on October 6-7, pending weather and field conditions. The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is relining a deteriorated sewer in the area.

The work is expected to start at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, October 6, and continue into the early morning hours of Tuesday, October 7. MSD is relining a 36-inch-diameter sewer between a manhole adjacent to 2022 Williams Avenue and a manhole on the elementary school grounds using a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining process. This is a trenchless technology, so no excavation work will occur, but the curing process does create non-toxic odors.

If anyone experiences odors inside their home or business, they should add water to their floor drain trap if it is dry.

Lane restrictions may occur near the manhole on Williams Avenue. Local access to homes will be maintained, but there could be delays. Please plan accordingly.

MSD's contractor, Inliner Solutions, will perform the work.
