## **UPDATE: Traffic Alert and Notice of Construction for Sedamsville**

*Project Completion Delayed; Westbound River Road Down to  
One Lane through Early May*

CINCINNATI – Westbound River Road in Sedamsville – between Fairbanks Avenue and Mt. Echo Drive – will remain down to one lane through early May, as the result of project delays caused by weather and field conditions.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is relining a 36-inch-diameter deteriorated sewer along River Road in three locations.

The relining work will start at 9:00 a.m. on April 7, April 9, and April 14 and continue into the early morning hours of the next day, weather permitting.

MSD's contractor, Inliner Solutions, will perform the work, using a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) technology. This lining technology does not require excavation, but the curing process creates temporary, non-toxic odors.
